3. Master Plan
  - A. Bayhill Park:  
Jenna Webb, resident, wants to see this park beautified for kids to play. She has been told that this park is in the General Plan, but nothing temporary can be done at this point to make it so kids can play there. The Committee discussed that the park is scheduled in the 2011 budget. Some ideas for that area were a loop for horse trailers to turn around and a tot lot. The Planning Commission has not seen the revised parks section of the General Plan. The Committee questioned why it hasn't been presented to the Planning Commission. The Committee discussed doing the park in phases, using the \$30,000 from Fieldcrest Park, fine tuning this park plan, and getting price estimates. If nothing is done at this time, weed abatement needs to be done. **Action item: Ashley Vogelsberg needs to forward the final section of the Park General Plan to the Planning Commission.**
  - B. Fieldcrest Park:  
Residents in the area put the kibosh on it.
  - C. Sage Vista Park:  
The Cedars Townhomes HOA is proposing a \$57.00 one time fee from each home to raise the needed \$10,000 for development. This plus the \$30,000 will do parking, a pavilion, gazebo, tables, benches, a tot lot, a minimum amount of lawn, desert landscaping, a retaining wall, and a trail head. They hope to get going by August.
