COUNCIL MEETING

1. This meeting of the City Council of the City of Cedar Hills, having been properly noticed, was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Mayor Richardson

Invocation given by C. Wright

Pledge of Allegiance led by Leatham Smith, Scout Troop 1206

2. Public Comment (7:07 p.m.)

Rod Lacey: Mr. Lacey thanked the City for work on the Community Recreation Center. He was present at the last City Council Meeting to talk about privacy fencing in The Cedars (West). He and an HOA board member came to explore the possibility. He wanted to make clear that privacy fencing was not a board-approved decision, but an exploration of the possibility.

Angela Johnson: Ms. Johnson stated that she does not want the City to hire aerobics instructors but would prefer to allow them to lease out the space. She would also like the Council to consider allowing two minutes of public comment during each agenda item.

Jerry Dearing: Mr. Dearing clarified that the language in the initiative petition is intended for the majority of voters that vote in a duly called election to determine whether the building would be built. The effective date of the petition was meant to be the day that it was applied for, and there is precedent for that in Utah.

7. Review/Action on Amendments to the Fiscal Year 2012 Budget (July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012)

Staff Presentation:

Mayor Richardson stated that the City did some remediation on the hillside by the water tanks. The City met with a geotech engineer, who was able to give the City a great rate and came up with great recommendations and solutions. The original estimate was over \$1 million. The end number was far less.

Konrad Hildebrandt stated that every year the City identifies problem areas along the hillside. The City was able to get complete remediation by moving and compaction of soil. The area was also reseeded. The anticipated amount for the project was \$85,000. Because of collaboration between the City and the construction company, the final dollar figure is \$75,000.

Council Discussion:

- C. Kirk stated that when the water tank was constructed, the hillside was deemed safe for construction. Now the area needed some remediation. He worries that over time more remediation needs to be done.
- C. Perry state that the water tank is built on solid rock. The remediation efforts are below the tanks.
- C. Martinez stated that she lives up in the area. She was prepared for the dump trucks and noise in the area. The remediation was quiet with minimal noise and mess.

MOTION: C. Kirk - To adopt Resolution No. 10-18-2011A, a resolution adopting the amended 2011-2012 Fiscal Year Budget for the City of Cedar Hills, Utah, for the hillside remediation project for \$75000 to be transferred from capital improvement projects to pay for the project. Seconded by C. Perry. Vote taken by roll call.

8. Review/Action on an Alternate Law with Initiative Petition (#4) Relative to the Construction or Purchase of Public Buildings in Excess of \$400,000 Excluding the Cost of Land (7:37 p.m.)

Presentation:

C. Perry stated that he had two significant concerns with the language of the proposed initiative petition. (1) It called for a majority of registered voters, rather than the majority of those that actually vote, which can cause a problem if something is passed without the majority. (2) There was language that was drafted to block the construction of the recreation center. Many who signed the initiative petition didn't intend to block the building but to have a voice in the building of public buildings. To avoid the unconstitutional nature of a retroactive law, he and C. Martinez drafted an alternate law that simply states: "No public building requiring more than \$400,000 of public funds for building construction shall be built without first being approved by voters in a duly called election." The \$400,000 number remains though arbitrary. Both this language and the initiative petition language will be on the ballot (November 2013). If both pass, any conflicts will be decided by the one that gets the most votes.

C. Martinez stated that she worked with C. Perry on this language. The intent was to be clear and simple.

MOTION: C. Kirk - To adopt the alternate petition to put before the voters in the election of 2013, the Council alternative of "No public building requiring more than \$400,000 of public funds for building construction shall be built without first being approved by voters in a duly called election. Seconded by C. Martinez.

Discussion:

- C. Martinez stated that the public needs to be educated. This election won't happen for another two years.
- C. Perry stated that there will be a voter information pamphlet with a "for" and "against" and with rebuttals for each of the proposed laws.
- Mayor Richardson stated that the City cannot take one position or the other. The City needs to remain totally objective.

Mayor Richardson reported that UTOPIA is moving forward with installation in Centerville and Layton.

C. Perry reported that the Lone Peak Public Safety District will be meeting in November where there will be a proposal to go to a population based distribution of cost with Cedar Hills getting full representation on the Board. He recommended another Council member attend the next meeting because he will be leaving the Council soon.

C. Kirk reported that the Dispatch Board came to an agreement with Media 8 regarding answering media requests. Dispatchers can verify the call and location. From there the media can contact the appropriate authorities. The North Point Solid Waste Special Service District finance committee met. Their contract with Allied ends soon. There have been talks about buying a landfill. The recommendation is no cost of living increase for employees for the fourth year in a row. The salvage program, which splits salvage proceeds between the district and the employees that participate, will be discussed soon.
