Item 7—Resolution Recognizing Cedar Hills Champions, Silver Beavers

Item 8—Cattery Ordinance

Chandler Goodwin stated that the language was changed to remove references to kennels and to allow up to six cats. Inspections are similar to those required for other business licenses. There are also very strict requirements for outdoor exercise areas. One issue to be addressed is litters. As currently written, the number of cats under 6 months is not limited.

C. Rees stated that if this is approved, the resolution on the ballot will state that it has been made law by the Council.

Item 10—Contract with a Public Relations firm

C. Rees stated that two firms presented their plans. The recommendation is to go with Radiate Creative. The goal is to brand the city as a whole and market the grill, golf course and recreation center.

C. Jackman stated that the Council needs to discuss the source of funding for this proposal.

Item 11—Request for Island Cutout on Cedar Hills Drive

C. Rees stated that Amsource requested this cutout.
