1. This meeting of the City Council of the City of Cedar Hills, having been properly noticed, was called to order at 4:32 p.m. by Mayor Gygi.
2. Review/Action to Accept and Certify the Results for Proposition #6, the Cedar Hills CARE Tax Opinion Question

Colleen Mulvey stated that pursuant to Utah election law it is necessary for the City Council to act as the board of canvassers and to canvass the election returns by reviewing and verifying the Statement of Votes Cast for Proposition #6, and make a motion to officially certify the results. The county has canvassed their general election and provided the city with the results: 2,019 voters voting for the proposition, and 2,174 voters voting against the proposition.
