



CEDAR HILLS IMPLEMENTS OUTDOOR WATER RESTRICTIONS

CEDAR HILLS – On May 5, 2015 the Cedar Hills City Council voted to implement outdoor water conservation measures for all water users within the city. This policy is effective May 9, 2015 and applies to residential and commercial users.

All addresses ending in an odd number will be allowed to water Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. All addresses ending in an even number will be allowed to water Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. Spot watering with a hose is allowed on Sunday. Restrictions will be enforced with a warning for the first violation, a \$50 fine for the second violation, and a \$200 fine for the third and subsequent violations.

The state of Utah continues to face serious drought conditions and the city encourages residents to utilize water-wise techniques to conserve water. Helpful information can be found online at slowtheflow.org. The city also encourages residents to schedule a free water check, which analyzes the efficiency of individual sprinkler systems. This is performed by trained workers who will provide a customized watering schedule. To schedule this water check, please visit slowtheflow.org or call 877-728-3420.
