The undersigned hereby makes application to excavate the above-mentioned Cedar Hills properties and/or cut into a Cedar Hills City street in the following manner:

- Surface repair shall be completed within ten (10) calendar days.
- Before replacing surface material, the remaining surface must be saw-cut six inches (6") wider than the trench on all sides.
- Material excavated will not be placed back under paved surfaces.
- Backfill shall consist of untreated base course from the pipe bedding to within three inches (3") of existing asphalt surface or match existing asphalt thickness with a minimum thickness of three inches (3"). Backfill shall be compacted to ninety-five percent (95%) of the maximum dry density.
- Asphalt shall be placed and tested as required by Section 6, Cedar Hills Standard Specifications.
- Concrete shall be placed and tested as required by Section 5, Cedar Hills Standard Specifications.
- Contractor shall notify Public Works Director one (1) working day in advance of work to be performed and also one (1) working day before any required inspection.
- Contractor shall guarantee work for two (2) years after the date of final inspection.
- The application must: (a) show proof that a competent, responsible, and licensed contractor will perform the work; (b) present evidence of public liability insurance in an amount of not less than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000); and (c) either post a minimum three thousand dollar (\$3,000) cash bond, an adequate performance bond or a minimum ten thousand dollar (\$10,000) blanket license/permit bond, to be determined by the Public Works Director. The cash bond or performance bond will be held by the City to guarantee that the required improvements and restoration and every part thereof, will remain in good condition for a period of two (2) years after final acceptance. The contractor must agree, at no cost to the City, to make all repairs to and maintain the improvements and every part thereof in good condition during the two (2) year guarantee period.
- Roads shall not be cut between October 31 and April 1 without permission from the Public Works Director, whether or not the permit has been issued.

I agree to comply with the above requirements, all applicable State and Federal Laws, all Cedar Hills City Standards, Specifications, Ordinances and other applicable requirements.
