JOB SUMMARY:

This is a part-time, non-benefited position requiring approximately 29 hours per week. This position is responsible for performing maintenance duties related to City property and parks including landscaping and irrigation repair.

DUTIES:

- Mowing/trimming of landscaping at City parks and properties
- Oversee general care and maintenance of turf, planting beds, etc.
- Clean and care for maintenance equipment
- Operation and use of vehicles, mowers, power equipment, and hand tools
- Use and updating maintenance records and reports
- Assist Public Works department technicians with various duties
- Additional duties performed, as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Requires ability to work in outdoor conditions
- Able to safely operate mowers, edgers, and other equipment/tools
- Basic knowledge of irrigation systems, including maintenance and repair
