



Mr. Goodwin explained the City should consider xeriscaping. While it was more expensive than watering grass it would provide water conservation. Mayor Rees stated that the current water restrictions were not effective. The Council discussed possible incentives to residents to promote conservation.

Mr. Goodwin said the State wanted the City to report water loss. They currently did not have this data. He said once they knew what the end user was consuming, they could report the losses.
