# Cedar Hills CARE/PARC revenues since 2009

- CARES/PARC tax funding & interest fiscal year ending June 30, 2009-2021 totaled **\$521,160.62**
  - *Fiscal year funding*
    - 2009 \$7,864.49, 2010 \$30,591.54, 2011 \$33,484.10, 2012 \$35,948.72, 2013 \$38,827.78, 2014 \$41,154.00, 2015 \$43,551.82, 2016 \$43,757.21, 2017 \$34,150.79, 2018 \$13,601.12, 2019 \$55,973.77, 2020 \$63,057.36, 2021 \$76,657.34
- Creekside funding 2016-2021 \$6,000-\$9,000 per year—total allocation \$39,000
- Projects PARC taxes contributed to but didn't fully fund
  - 2012 Heritage Park Basketball court \$36K
  - 2013 Community Center basement \$385K
  - 2014 Mesquite Park restroom \$77K
  - 2016-2017 Bayhill Park restroom finishes \$11K, playground & court \$118K, pavilion 60K
  - 2018-2020 Harvey park development, splash pad, playground & shade, courts, etc. \$4.5 million
  - 2021 Bayhill park landscape \$81K playground surfacing and swing \$61K
  - 2022 Doral park playground, swings \$53K and surfacing \$50K, benches, \$3K

# Recommended locations for PARC tax signs

- Heritage park basketball court area approximately \$36K
- Heritage amphitheater area for Creekside contributions \$39K
- Harvey park basketball court area with lighting approximately \$75K
- Harvey park shade sails in the playground area \$58K
- Hightfit/Dance/Karate room at Community Center ¼ part of \$385K addition & elevator improvement
- Mesquite park bathroom \$77K
- Bayhill park playground, swing, hoops, surfacing approximately \$170K
- Doral park playground and surfacing \$103K
