Noticed Agenda Items for the Regular Council Meeting (6:06 p.m.)

Annexation of the Earl Property

Mayor Gygi stated that this will just be a discussion item. There were some notifications that needed to be made, but were not, so no action can be taken at this time.

Gretchen Gordon stated that the homeowner is required to provide a survey map and pay some fees, which has not yet been done. At this point the City can hold the public hearing, but after that the ball is in their court. The Earls are currently connected and are paying the resident rate because they are vested in the process.

Arielle Martin

C. Augustus stated that Arielle Martin is not competing in the 2012 Olympics because she was injured in a training run. She lacerated her spleen, punctured her lungs and several other injuries. She has been in intensive care and has had a number of surgeries. C. Augustus was trying to organize an Olympic viewing party at the Community Recreation Center. Now he would like to adopt a resolution making August 8, 2012, Arielle Martin Day. During the meeting he would like to read the resolution into the record.

Gretchen Gordon stated that Arielle was raised in Cedar Hills, and her mother was very involved in the community and served on the Planning Commission.

City Visions and Goals

Mayor Gygi stated that he wants to renew this discussion of visions with concrete goals to accomplish that vision. The City Council will come up with the visions and goals and the city staff will work on implementing them. He would like Cedar Hills to be known for something and the City Council should be proactive in establishing that.

David Bunker stated that the city staff will look at the broad goals and work on the steps that are necessary to accomplish it on a department level. He would like to see a more defined city mission statement.
