

Cedar Hills Parks FAQ

Q: How do I make a park reservation online?

A: Reservations for park pavilions are available From April 15 to October 15 (restrooms will be open during these dates.) City residents pay \$8 per hour per venue, and non-residents pay \$16 per hour per venue. Refunds are available up to seven (7) days before the scheduled reservation. A \$15 service fee is retained from all refund requests. Reservations may be made 1 year in advance.

All reservations are made online through [RECI](#).

- Sign in or create a new account (tip: if you have registered for any of our rec programs it's the same username and password).
- Once logged in you will be able to see the calendar of available dates. Select the park, venue/facility, and time you would like to reserve then add it to your cart.
- It will then walk you through the checkout and payment process.

Q: What are the hours of Cedar Hills parks?

A: Parks are open from 5:00am until 10:00pm. The hours from 5:00am- 7:00am are quiet hours only! (Walking or jogging are ok; music or sporting activities are not ok). Anyone in the park during the hours it is closed (10:00pm and 5:00am) will be subject to citation. (City employees or authorized personnel may be in the park after hours if they are performing required duties)

Q: Are inflatables allowed in city parks?

A: No. Inflatables, tents, waterslides, etc. are not allowed in any Cedar Hills parks.

Q: I left something in the park. Do you have a Lost and Found?

A: Items found at a park will remain at the park for owner retrieval for a short period of time. Anything at the park for an extended period of time will be thrown away or donated. Items of higher value (electronics, phones, keys, etc.) will be taken to the city offices if found.

Q: When will the splash pad at Harvey Park turn on for the season?

A: The splash pad is turned on for the season on Memorial Day and runs through Labor Day. Our 2022 splashpad schedule has been set to conserve water and will not be turned on at any time outside the current schedule of Wednesdays, Friday & Saturdays 12pm-7pm.

Q: Can I hold a large company party or wedding in a city park?

A: Large groups (in excess of 200 people) or commercial user will need to apply for a [Special Events Permit](#). The processing time for special event permits is 60 days.

Q: Can I reserve city grass or baseball fields for team practices?

A: No. Outside of city recreation games we do not reserve any fields for any individual team practices. All park fields are first come, first served.

Other things to remember:

- Grass is mowed in the parks on **TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, and THURSDAY**.
- None of the parks have hose bibs available to the public and some of the venues do not have electricity. Please see individual parks for specific amenities.
