

PARK FACILITY RULES AND USAGE

Cedar Hills takes great pride in its beautiful parks and trails.

We ask that you care for them properly.

RESERVATION RULES

- From April 15 to October 15, city park facilities may be reserved. Reservation fees must be paid prior to any scheduling. City residents pay \$8 per hour per venue and non-residents pay \$16 per hour per venue. Refunds are available up to seven (7) days before the scheduled reservation. A \$15 service fee is retained from the refund. **Some dates may not be available due to city events.**
- Reservations may only be made for times during regular park hours. Only facilities and venues listed may be reserved.
- Reservations are scheduled in hour increments.
- Users should allow for set-up and clean-up time during their reservation. Parks are heavily used during the summer months, so please be courteous of other reservations by beginning and ending your event promptly.
- An additional fee may be assessed for parties leaving excess trash and debris at facilities.
- Large groups (exceeding 200), commercial users, or groups with special requests will need to contact the city for a Special Events Application. This application is REQUIRED and may include additional fees and acquisition of appropriate permits, licenses, and liability waivers which city personnel will need prior to approval.
- Inflatables, bounce houses, tents, waterslides, etc. are NOT permitted in any city park.
- Reservations may be voided if ALL Park Facility Rules are not followed.

GENERAL PARK RULES

- Park hours are from 5:00am to 10:00pm with quiet hours from 5:00am to 7:00am.
- Vehicles are NOT permitted on the park grass or the asphalt paths. Vehicles are NOT to leave the designated parking areas.
- Pets are welcome in the park areas if they are on a leash. Owners are responsible to remove any waste left behind.
- Picnic tables are NOT to be removed from the pavilions.
- Water features, culverts, and streams may be present on park property. Individuals entering the water do so at their own risk. Creek water is overflow irrigation water; flow will fluctuate based on usage demands.
- Adult supervision is required at all times.
- Consumption of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco are strictly prohibited in all city parks.
- Overnight camping and/or open fires are NOT allowed at any time in any city park or surrounding areas.
- Groups playing music must conform to the city noise ordinances.
- The City of Cedar Hills is NOT liable for any injury or consequence of park usage.

PARK CONDITIONS

- Power capabilities are 15 amps per outlet. Staff may not be available to reset overloaded breakers.
- Grass is mowed in the parks on TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, and THURSDAY.
- None of the parks have hose bibs or drinking water available.
- Not all venues have electricity. Please check the parks amenities on our website.
